AMP Kingston is a National Lottery Heritage Fund (NLHF) supported project, exploring and celebrating Kingston's musical heritage from the 1960s – present day.

Through a mix of oral histories, archive material and intergenerational community responses, this range of displays aims to connect the community to the rich cultural legacy of the area, and inspire and support the next generation of creatives.

The exhibition is part of a wider Heritage Trail across Kingston and neighbouring areas from 2nd February 2024, including Fusebox, Kingston Museum, Kingston University, The Fighting Cocks, The Grey Horse, The Lamb, The Stanley Picker Gallery and the Eel Pie Island Museum.
